


The Somerset Exmoor Coast - Campaign Graphics




Visit the sweeping sandy beach of Minehead and explore the fascinating geology at Kilve beach, a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) - there is something for everyone to enjoy!

From Minehead pick up the South West Coastal Path (SWCP) the official start/end point for this challenging but incredibly rewarding National Trail.
